All our children have been working very hard in preparation for the phonics screening, which consists of each pupil reading a list of both real and 'alien' words. This will be very similar to the phonics work they have been doing in class. Reading each day with your child is the best way to support their reading development. Attendance over this time is important, so please ensure that all pupils are in school every day.
