For a wonderfully positive return to school - your joy and enthusiasm are infectious.

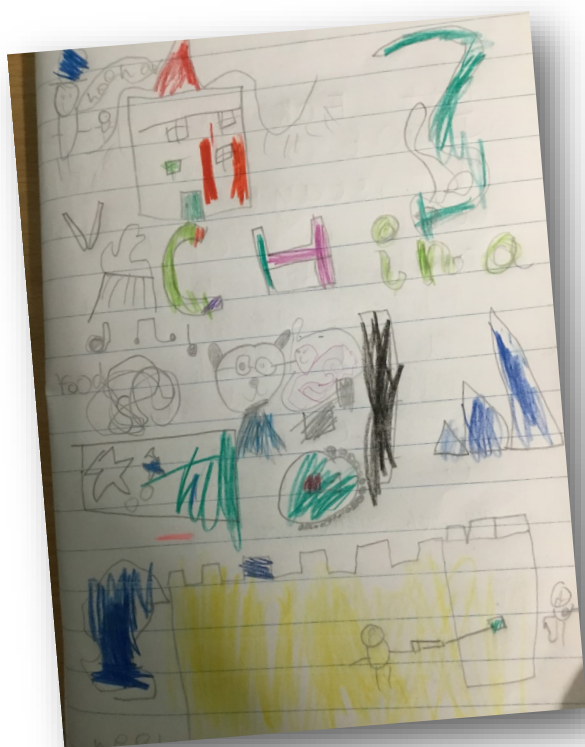


Choughs Class
