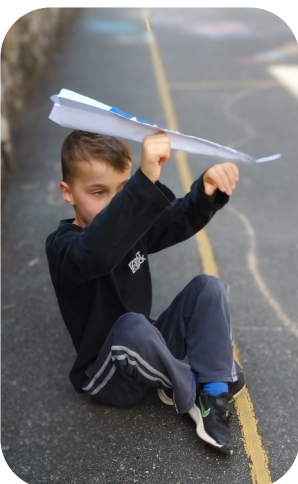
## Cargo planes!

The most successful design was Morvy's which carried 16 pennies and still flew across the playground!

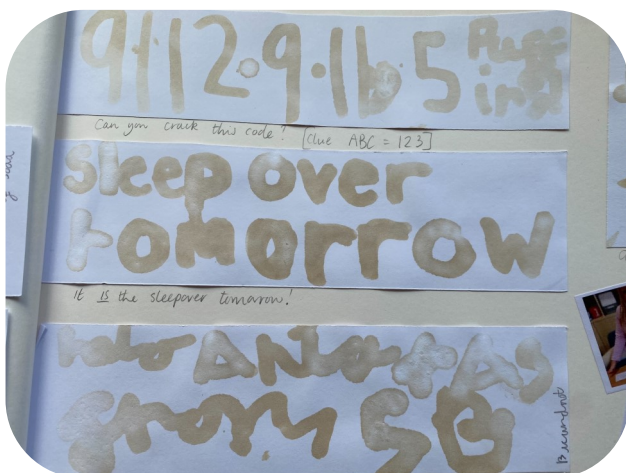


# Secret Messages using invisible ink!

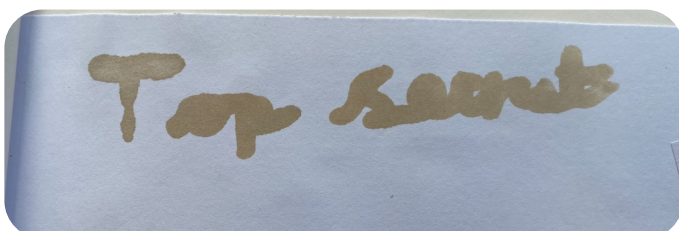

Putting the strawberries in the chocolate fountain was the best thing ever!- HT

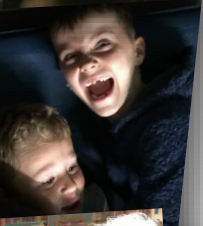
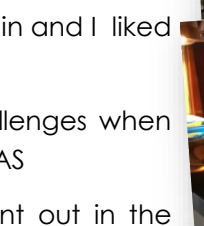
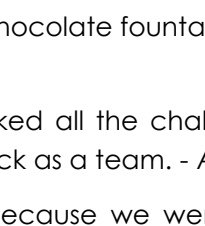
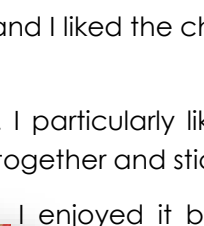
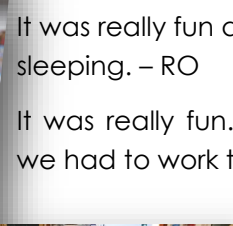
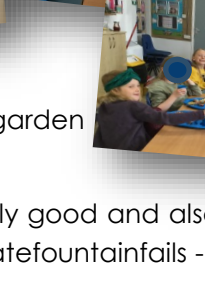
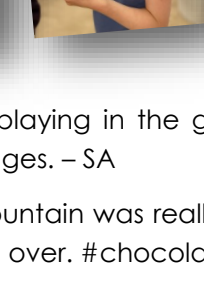
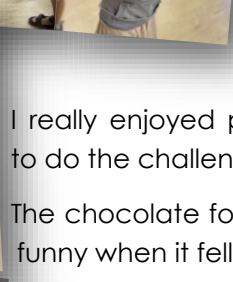
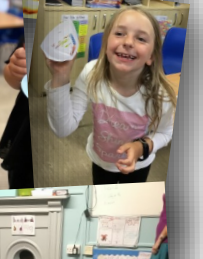
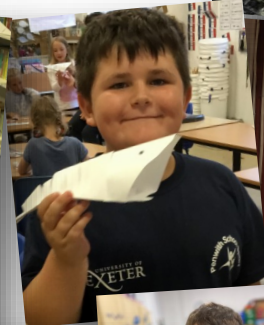
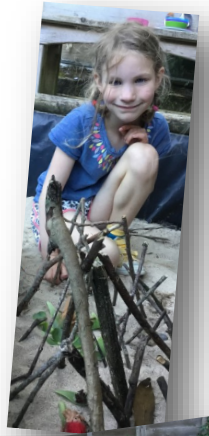
I really enjoyed playing in the garden to do the challenges. – SA
