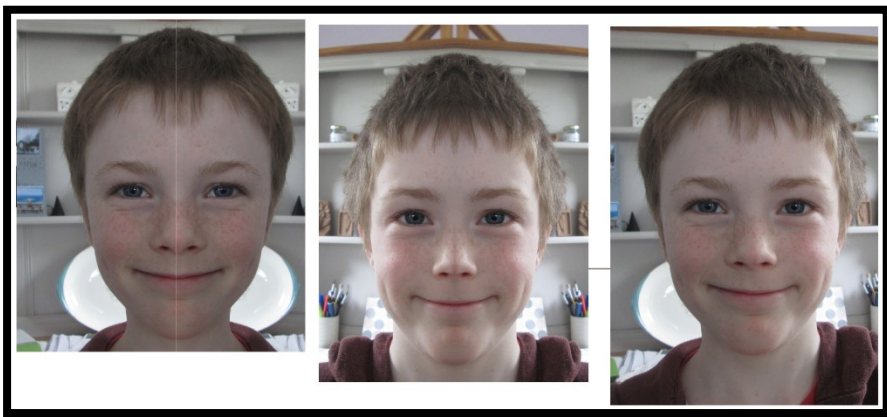

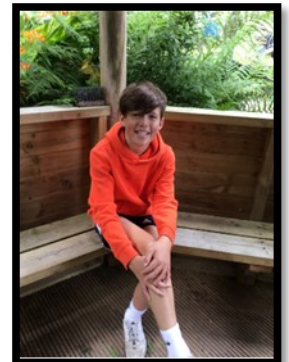


Alert Stoodents.
