Dear Families,

As part of our learning in Science on habitats, life cycles, and the classification of plants and animals, we are excited to share that Puffins Class have been invited to visit St Levan Churchyard next Monday.

This visit links closely to an important community project. There are currently fundraising efforts underway to repair the roof of this historic church, with parts of the building dating back to Anglo-Saxon times. We are proud to be able to support and learn from such an important part of the St Levan community, of which we are a part.

During our visit, the children will take part in a range of hands-on scientific activities, including:

- Testing soil pH
- Measuring light levels
- Observing and identifying plants and animals
- Exploring different features of the habitat

This will be the first of a series of visits across the year. Each term, we will return to the churchyard to observe how the environment changes with the seasons. As part of this ongoing project, the children will create reports and develop dichotomous keys that can be used by others to identify wildlife within the churchyard.

There is no cost for this visit. The children will travel by minibus, have lunch at school and will return in time for the end of the school day.

Please ensure your child comes to school prepared for outdoor learning, with appropriate clothing and footwear for the weather.

We are very much looking forward to this opportunity to combine our science learning with meaningful engagement in our local community.
