They explored how Impressionist artists used visible brush strokes and carefully mixed colours to capture light and atmosphere. Working with a limited colour palette, Puffins experimented with colour matching, layering paint and creating different brush stroke effects. We were incredibly impressed with the focus, patience and artistic skill shown throughout the lessons – well done!

Chysauster and Men-an-Tol

What a busy week! Choughs ended it by visiting local ancient sites, Chysauster village and Men-an-Tol. We met Adrian from English Heritage who told us all about how people might have lived in the past, using different artefacts to explain grinding flour and stripping wool from sheep. We explored Chysauster, identified the features of the houses there, solved some challenges and then hopped over to Men-an-Tol. We saw so many exciting things to sketch on the way that there wasn't much time for sketching when we got there! We look forward to a follow-up art session with Sarah (R's Mum) when we're back at school on Monday. A bit more time to explore using the charcoal and talk about the colours in the landscape will really help us get the most out of this lovely trip. Thank you to all our adult helpers on the day!



Men-an-Tol watercolours

We talked about the background and foreground and mixed different paints with water to recreate the colours we had seen.
