Choughs visit to Marazion Marsh on Monday 28th November

As part of our Sky topic this term, we are learning about the artist JMW Turner who was famous for painting 'en plein air'. He was known for braving all weathers to sketch and paint his masterpieces so we are going to do the same.

On Monday 28th November, we will be visiting the marsh and beach at Marazion to sketch and paint like Turner. We will also do a bit of bird watching on the RSPB reserve and make observations about the weather. We will be leaving immediately after morning registration, travelling by hired coach and returning to school in time for lunch. Please could you make sure that you arrive punctually (as usual) so we can leave as soon as possible after 9.00am.
