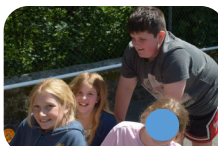
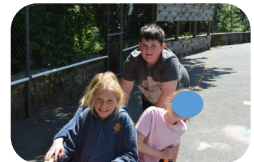
A Huge Well Done to Our Year 6s!

What's the difference between a pond skater and a water boatman?

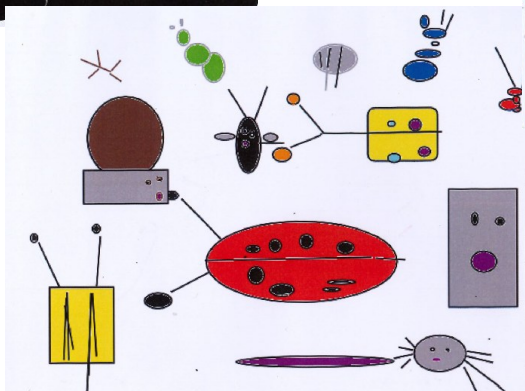
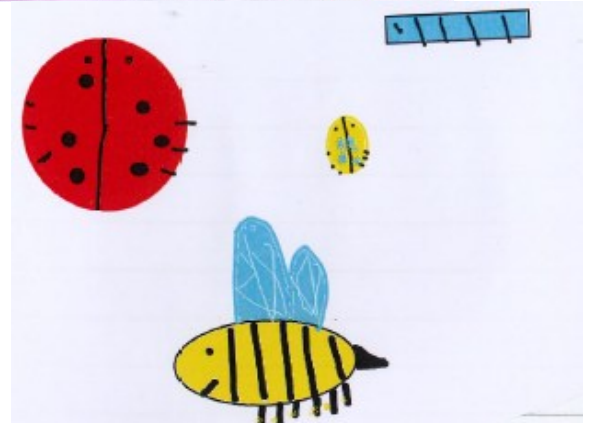
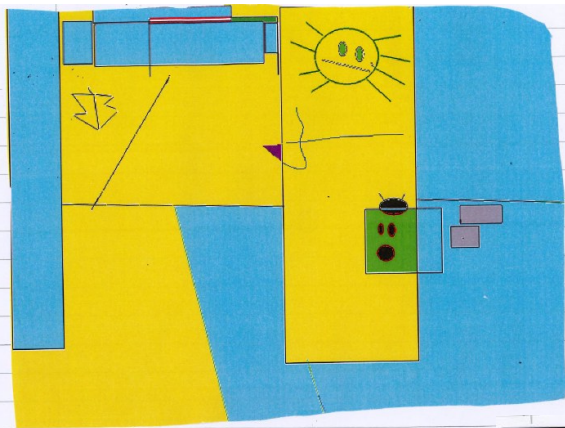
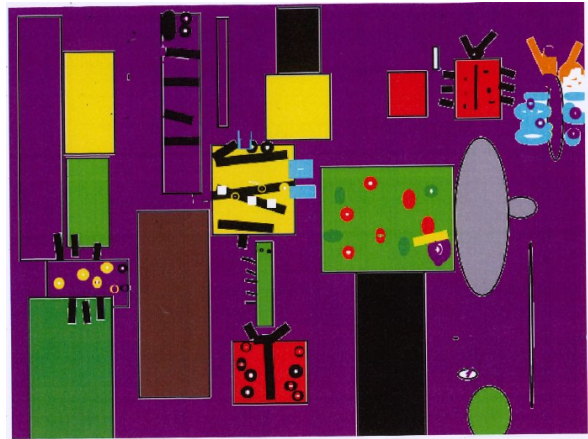
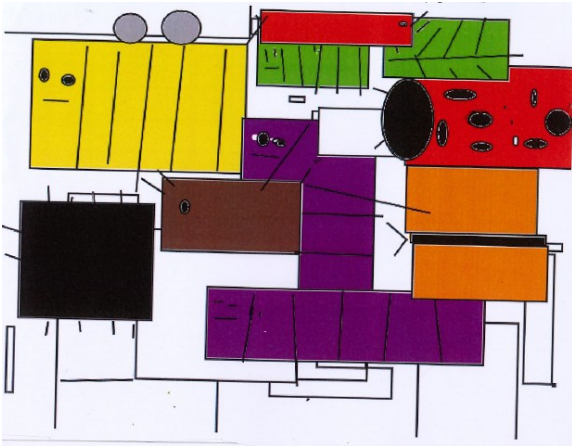
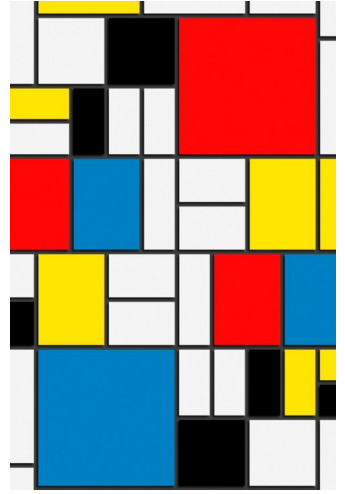
