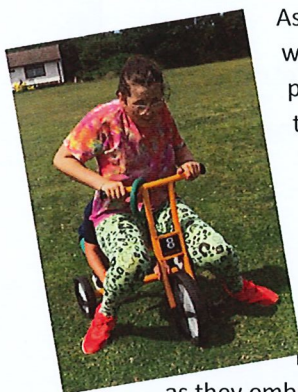
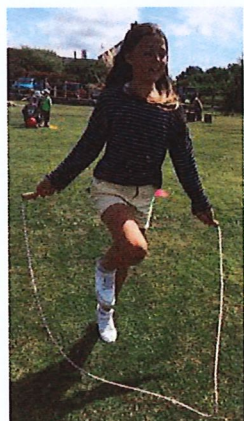


Dear parents,

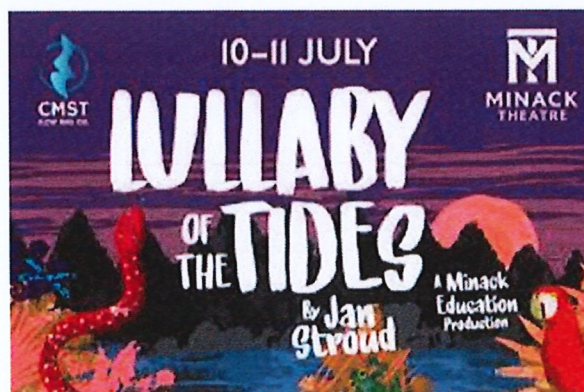


We are also delighted to have entered the library's short story competition this week. More on this in the new academic year!



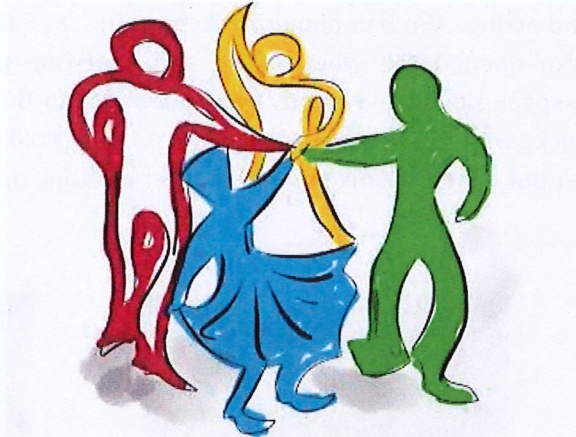
## Lullaby of the Tides – what a super evening!
