Investigating Light in Puffins Class

This week, Puffins have been busy acting as young scientists, exploring the question: Do smooth surfaces reflect more light? Working in pairs, they tested a range of materials including foil, cardboard, plastic and mirrors. Using torches in a darkened classroom, they observed how the light beams bounced off each surface.

The children quickly discovered that shiny materials such as foil and mirrors reflected the light much more strongly, while duller surfaces like card absorbed most of it. They recorded their results carefully and shared their ideas about why this might happen.
