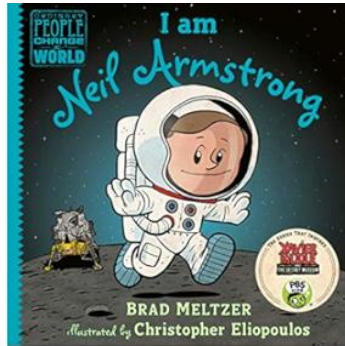

Space

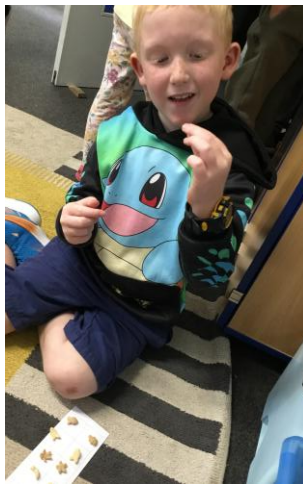
Choughs have been getting stuck into the Space topic this week. We enjoyed watching a video about the relative size of objects in space. We were shocked!
