Well done to BH-J for creating this excellent 3D model of the water cycle. It clearly demonstrates each stage of the cycle and shows real thought and creativity.

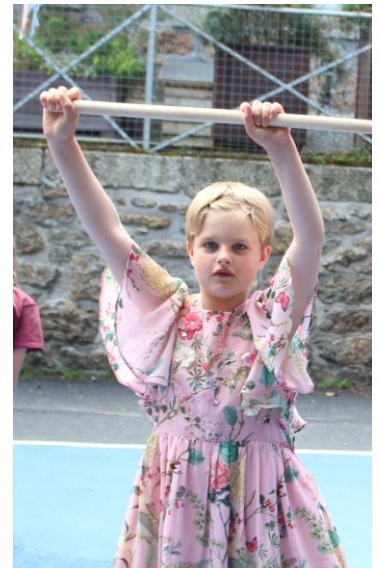
Look closely and you'll spot some brilliant details, including a pickleball sun and oyster mountains. A fantastic piece of learning, B - well done!

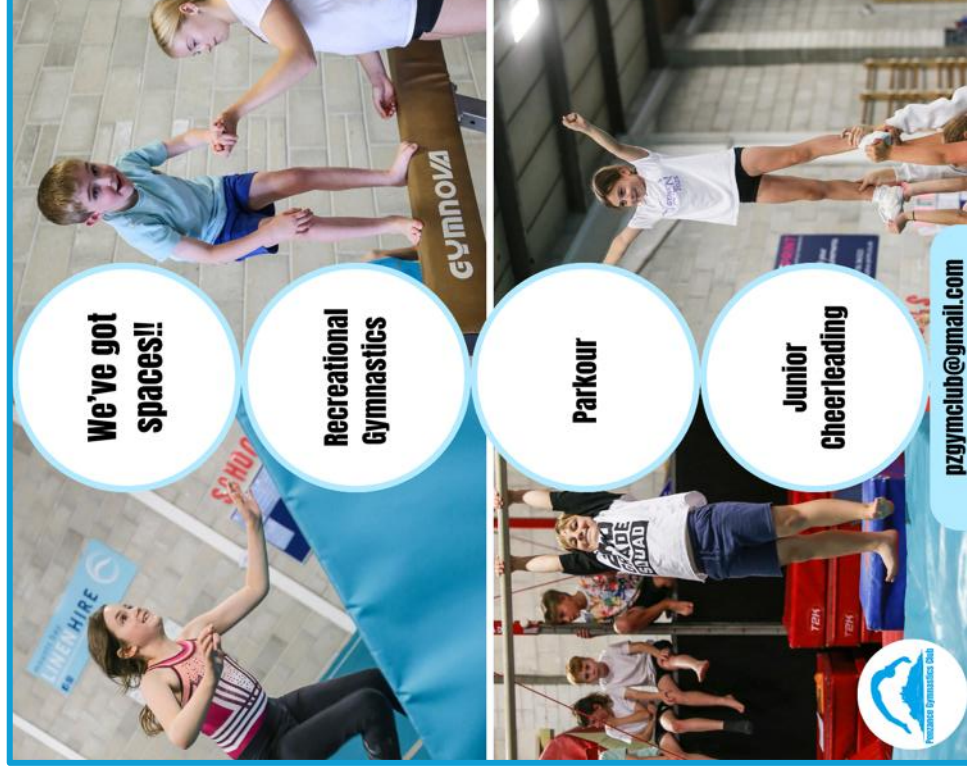
