On Thursday, we were treated to another amazing performance by the Elmore Quartet. We hope they inspire our children to enjoy live music, whether it be as a performer or an audience member.


Later today, we welcome under 5's and their families for Little Levans. We are looking forward to seeing them, it feels like such a while since the last Little Levans sessions ended.

On Thursday, Puffins warmly welcomed our friends from the Elmore Quartet, a professional string quartet based in London. They treated us to a wide range of music, from the classical sounds of Beethoven and Haydn to the more unusual and dissonant music of Bartók.

The children listened with real focus and curiosity throughout. The quartet commented on their excellent listening skills and the thoughtful questions they asked. One highlight was finding out how you travel on a plane with a cello - you have to buy it its own seat but it does not get an extra meal!





We also took part in a brilliant musical guessing game, where the quartet played just 2–4 notes from well-known film scores for us to identify before performing the full piece. A special mention goes to RO who correctly guessed *Pirates of the Caribbean* from just three notes - even more impressive as they were all the same note!

We are always proud of Puffins and it was wonderful to hear the quartet praising their behaviour, engagement and enthusiasm.

Rainforest Printing
