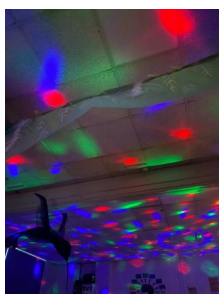
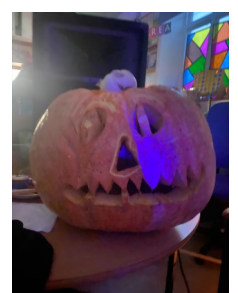
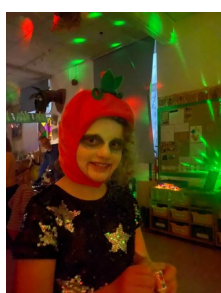
# Halloween Happenings!

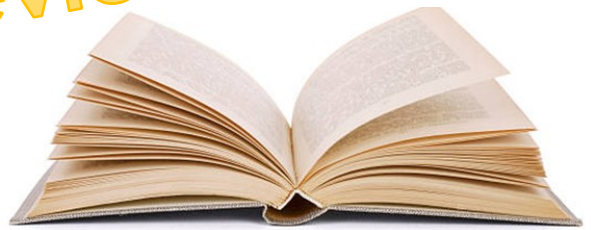
## Bessie Coleman
