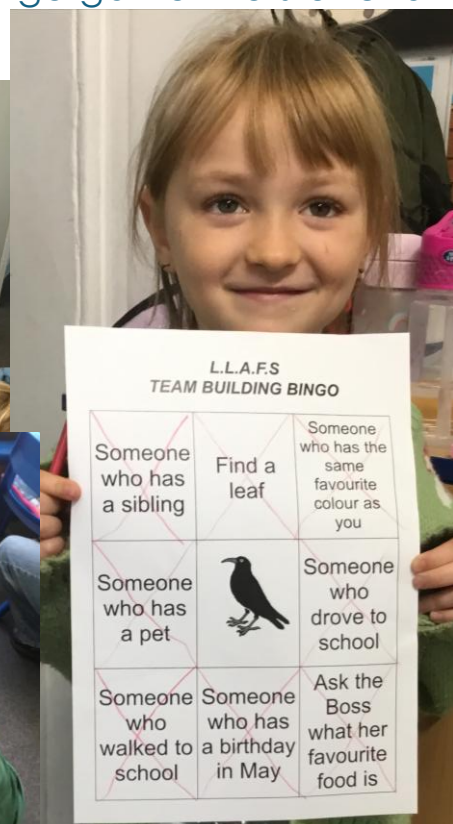

Help design of the next series of banknotes



The public are being asked to give their views on a selection of wildlife, native to the UK, that will appear on the next series of banknotes. Working with a panel of wildlife experts from across the UK, the Bank of England has produced a shortlist of animals that could become the central image on the £5, £10, £20 and £50 notes. The list has been grouped into three categories, which cover a variety of species and environments. Each banknote will feature a different animal, making them easily recognisable to the public. The shortlist is:

Mammals	Birds	Amphibians, insects and fish
bottlenose dolphin	Atlantic puffin	Atlantic salmon
brown hare	barn owl	basking shark
European hedgehog	common kingfisher	buff-tailed bumblebee
grey seal	Eurasian curlew	common frog
pine marten	great spotted woodpecker	Emperor dragonfly
red fox	white-tailed eagle	marsh fritillary butterfly
