


# Anglo Saxon Art in Puffins

Last Thursday, Puffins settled straight back into learning after our time away, completing plenty of maths and writing as well as grammar and spelling with enthusiasm – well done Puffs! It was also great to see some thoughtful home learning from those who had internet access – thank you for supporting this where you could.

In class, Puffins have been exploring Anglo-Saxon art, looking closely at the motifs, interlocking patterns and geometric designs used on ornate objects from the period. They've spent time observing details carefully and have begun sketching a range of Anglo-Saxon items, focusing on shape, pattern and structure.



# Cocoavamango smoothies



Choughs kicked off their Rainforest topic this term by learning about the different products which come from the rainforest. We used only our noses to identify chocolate (cocoa), coffee, cinnamon and cake (which turned out to be vanilla!).



Next, we played a memory game to remember as many rainforest products as we could!

We then talked about rainforest fruits and made delicious smoothies based on the Cocoavamango song. As we cut open the fruits, we looked at the seeds inside and talked about why plants grow fruits at all.



We're going to have a go at growing some of the seeds but Storm Goretti meant we had to make and then drink our smoothies very quickly. In the end, they were more like 'chunkies' than 'smoothies'... still scrummy though!
