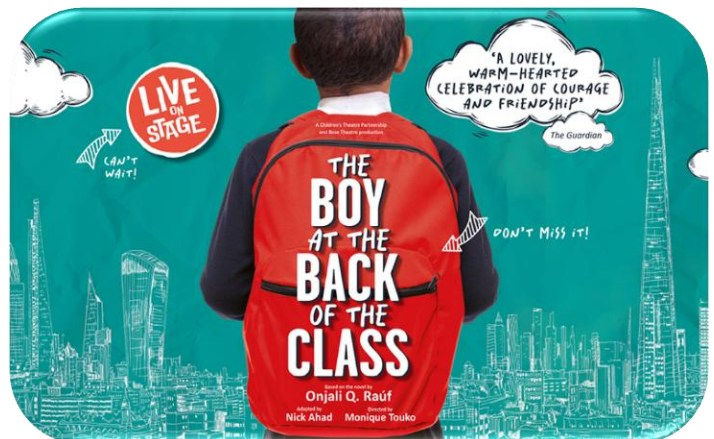


Puffins Visit the Theatre

Yesterday, Year 5/6 Puffins visited Hall for Cornwall to watch the stage adaptation of *The Boy at the Back of the Class* by Onjali Q. Rauf. Everyone represented the school extremely well from start to finish, with excellent behaviour throughout the journey, in the theatre and during the performance.

The show brought the book to life in a thoughtful and engaging way. It was great to recognise many original moments and to see how some parts had been adapted for the stage. The performance also highlighted the work we are doing on prejudice alongside other schools in the area, giving the children a powerful way to reflect on these themes.

The set was particularly memorable, a large gymnasium-style climbing frame used cleverly to create different scenes, and the pomegranate scene was just as moving as it is in the book. A fantastic experience all round and a great way to deepen our understanding of a text we know well.
